Adaptive Intervention Model (AIM) Coaching is an **adaptive coaching system** for instructional leaders to promote a schoolwide adolescent literacy model. Using AIM Coaching, instructional leaders provide **ongoing professional development** to middle school teachers, differentiated based on teachers' levels of skill and will, as they implement **evidence-based literacy practices** through the Promoting Adolescents' Comprehension of Text (PACT) intervention.
